You need to show continuous progress. That means attending classes regularly and maintaining a good attitude in class

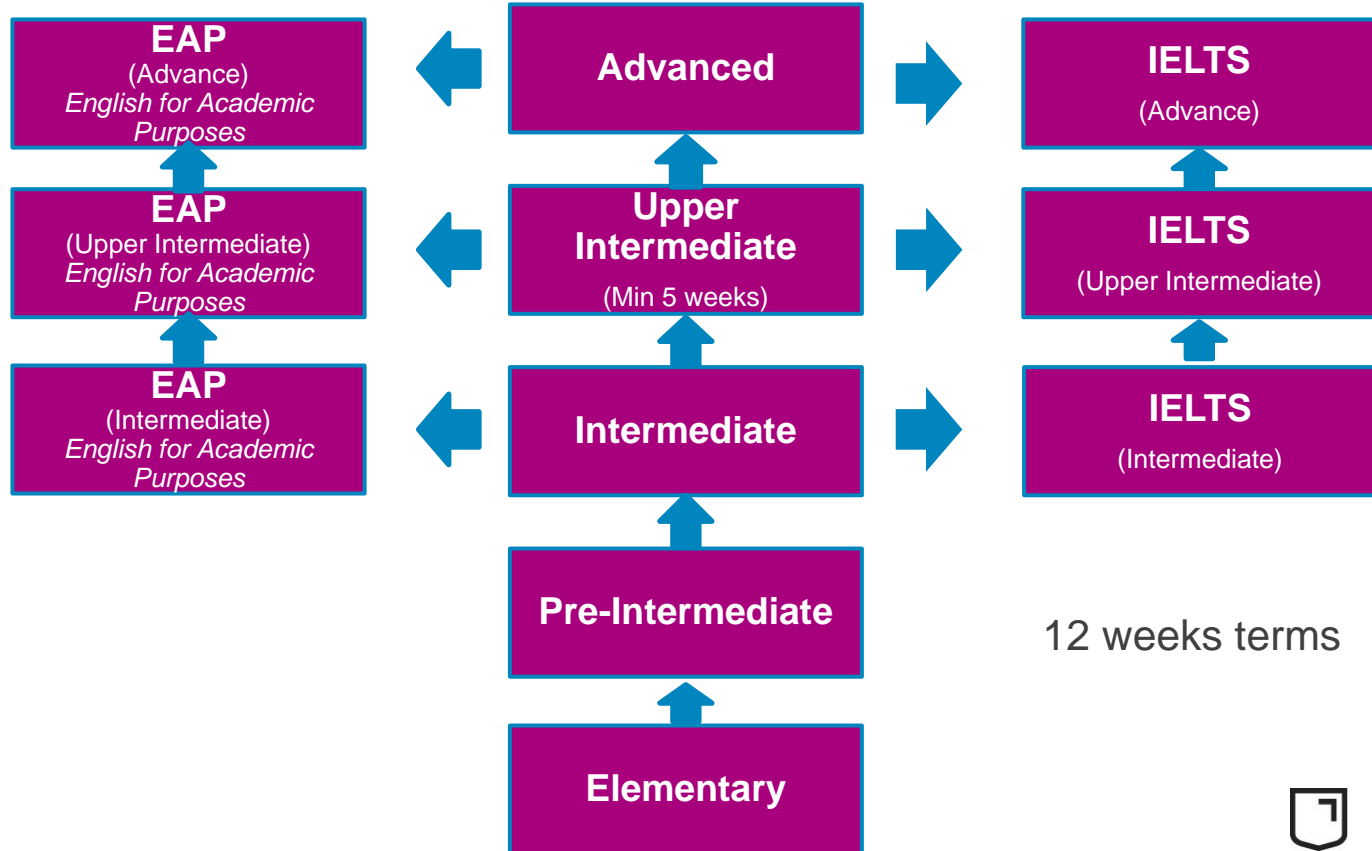
Weekly Assessments (Reading, Writing, Listening, Speaking, Grammar)

Student Visa

- No more than 40 hours fortnight during study period
- Spouse (Same as above)
- Full-time work allowance during holiday breaks only

Working Holiday Visa

- Full-time work Allowance
- Can only work a maximum of 6 months with the same employer

Tourist Visa

- No work allowance

LEAVE OF ABSENCE, DEFERMENT, SUSPENSION & CANCELLATION POLICY

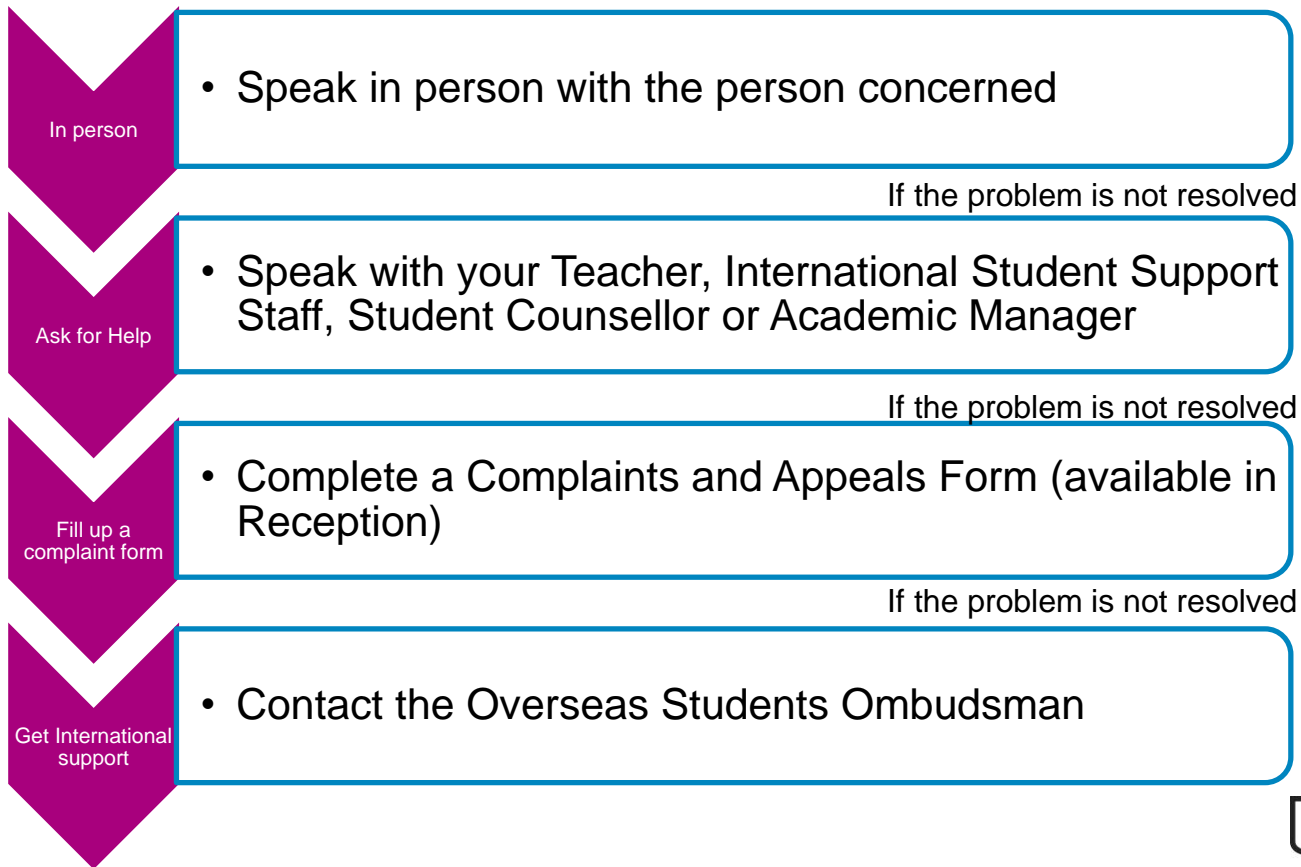
Fusion will only grant any of the above if they are Compassionate and Compelling reasons

ADVICE FROM THE EXPERTS

- + Practice, practice, practice!
 - + Teach other people
 - + Homework is really important
 - + Take responsibility for your learning
 - if you want extra homework, ask your teacher
 - Ask lots of questions in class
 - + Ask lots of questions in class
 - + Do extra writing at home (diary or daily experiences, vocab. Lists, Synonym Sentences)
 - + Total immersion (reduce the use of your Native Language (L1), and increase your use of English)
 - + **How much English do you REALLY speak/read/write/listen to outside of school?**
 - + The first couple of months of immersion are difficult, but if you can get through this period, things will get much easier!
 - + Understanding = 10% - Producing = 90%
 - + Make Aussie friends (Aussie or English-speaking) as soon as possible, even if you are shy (meetup.com, Facebook groups, volunteering)
- You will have a much better experience (can help with homesickness and can help you become part of culture)
- + Read as much as you can
 - books, magazines, internet websites
