



- To understand: knowledge, skills, attitudes and behaviors that you posses


According to results, teacher or academic manager decides when to move to the next level

WORKING RIGHTS IN AUSTRALIA



Student Visa

- No more than 40 hours fortnight during study period
- Spouse (Same as above)
- Full-time work allowance during holiday breaks only

Working Holiday Visa

- Full time work Allowance
- Can only work a maximum of 6 months with the same employer

Tourist Visa

- No work allowance







LEAVE OF ABSENCE, DEFERMENT, SUSPENSION & CANCELLATION POLICY



Fusion will only grant any of these requirements as long as they fall into the Compassionate and Compelling Circumstances policy and procedure

- + These circumstances would be considered on the student's course progress and well being.
 - A serious medical condition or injury
 - A bereavement of close family members such as parents or grandparents
 - A major political upheaval or natural disaster in the home country
 - A traumatic event (witnessing of an accident, crime committed against student or student witnessed a crime
